

TEFAF UNVEILS DESIGN PLANS FOR TEFAF NEW YORK FALL

Dutch firm Tom Postma Design to transform the Park Avenue Armory for the U.S. fair's debut

(New York) September 22, 2016 – The international art fair **TEFAF New York Fall**, a joint venture between TEFAF (The European Fine Art Foundation) and Artvest Partners, has engaged Tom Postma Design to transform the historic Park Avenue Armory in New York City from October 22-26, 2016, for its inaugural edition. **TEFAF New York Fall** will feature 94 of the world's most illustrious dealers of fine art, design, furniture, and jewelry from antiquity through the early 20th century. The fair will carry the signature visual identity of TEFAF Maastricht, Europe's biggest and most prestigious art and antiques fair, giving visitors a taste of the world-renowned Dutch event that takes place annually in March.

"I added a second skin. It's a complete turnaround situation, from dark to light," said Tom Postma, founder of the eponymous design firm. "People who've been going there for years and years, even those who live around the corner, will see something different than they've ever seen before. It is also the first time that the public is allowed to visit the beautifully restored rooms."

Upon entering the double doors of the Park Avenue Armory, visitors will be immersed in the distinct TEFAF experience—a combination of clean architectural forms with an awe-inspiring floral presentation. The design, which builds on Tom Postma's presentation commissioned for TEFAF Maastricht, creates a dramatic platform for exhibiting and viewing the museum-quality works of art.

Tom Postma's designs for TEFAF New York Fall will encompass most of the Park Avenue Armory. The elegant treatment will carry through the period rooms on the 1st and 2nd floor, the Armory's public areas, the loan exhibition, restaurant space, as well as the main exhibition space in the Drill Hall.

Bathed in light, neutral tones and translucent fabric, Tom Postma will deftly balance the historical integrity of the landmark building with a more modern architectural approach. The Armory was built as both a military facility and social club in 1861 by the prestigious Seventh Regiment of the National Guard. TEFAF New York is the first art fair to utilize the reception rooms on the first floor and the company rooms on the second floor in addition to the 55,000 square foot Drill Hall as exhibition space. This is the first time that several of the historical period rooms on the second floor of the Armory will be open to the public.
